The month's events have been chronologically summarized below:

1. **Carter Road Project** has been continued in this month, wherein the NSS members go to Carter Road (Bandra) and assist in the education of 40-50 underprivileged children who assemble everyday to learn from 6.45am to 9.00am.

2. Ashiana

Another project has been initiated under Education – Ashiana, a school for autistic children. NM NSS students assist the teachers in their task of teaching the students. There are two slots of students per day – Morning (10:30 – 12:15) and Afternoon (1:30 – 3:15.)

3. NSS Camp

This year the NSS camp was scheduled from 9th December to 15th December at Ashram Shala Padghe, Umroli, near Palghar. This was an effort to improve the lives of the school children and widen their horizons. The children were initiated and trained in 4 sports: chess, football, volleyball and badminton. They were also taught creativity in embroidery, origami, use of scrap materials etc, Basic knowledge of First Aid, Awareness to Girl students about 'Good Touch, Bad Touch' etc. Our NSS Volunteers performed Skit on Women Empowerment and the way school kids shared their learning from the skit was amazing and made us realized that the skit served the purpose. NSS unit donated the sports and crafts material, Computers to School and Stationery and Old cloths to School Kids and their parents.

Our efforts were much appreciated by the school faculty and students, as well as the Sarpanch of the taluka.

4. Energy Conservation

On the Carnival Day of our college (24th December) a stall was put up in college premises by the NSS students where the students could come and play a game. The aim of the game was to divide the materials written on pieces of paper into bio-degradable, non-biodegradable and hazardous waste. This helped raise awareness regarding disposal of waste.
