The monthly events have been chronologically summarized below:

- 1) The rakhi and other articles selling were continued from last month till the 8th of August 2013. This event was tremendously successful and earned a total of Rs 1,40,000 for the three institutions. More importantly all the volunteers who participated in this event were successful in creating awareness about how this activity generates an income for specially abled children, blind persons and Tribal women not only within college premises but also in the shops nearby and various other areas. The in charges of the event were felicitated on Independence day by Valabhdas Dagara Indian Society for the work done by the volunteers of N.M College of Commerce and Economics in sensitizing the youth about specially abled children and also as we had the highest sales among various other colleges.
- 2) In the wake of Independence Day the NM NSS volunteers also sold flags made by Hitech Family Foundation, a registered NGO. Independence Day was also celebrated by the NM NSS Volunteers at the college premises where our esteemed principal unfolded the tri colour. The NM NSS members also attended the Independence Day celebration held at the Kalina University.
- 3) Carter road project, an area project under education was also initiated in the month of August. The project was adopted by the NM NSS unit last year. The NSS members go to Carter road bandra where 40-50 underprivileged children assemble everyday to learn from 6.45am to 9.00am and tutor to these kids.
- 4) The NM NSS members attended a seminar named Chatra Sansad on the topic of The Constitution of India held on the 24th and 25th of August 27, 2013. The seminar was of 6hrs on each day and was attended by over 400 students from various colleges.
- 5) Along with the various activities mentioned above the Blood donation drive preparation was also started in the month of August. The NSS unit performed skits in every class, put up charts in the colleges and carried out various other activities to ensure that the importance of blood donation was spread throughout the college. Along with Blood donation drive the NSS unit conducted Thalassemia checkups with the help of C.B Patil which was mandatory for Third year students on the 30th and 31st of August. The blood donation drive took place on the 31st of August 2013.
