The event was an impromptu speech wherein topics were given on the spot and participants had to speak for a minimum of 2 minutes to qualify and maximum 3 minutes. No pauses were allowed in between. Participants were not allowed to speak word continuously for more than 3 times and not more than 10 times during the entire course of their speech. The rules and regulations throughout the event were strictly adhered to.
