

## **Placement Activities Undertaken:**

### **WORKSHOP 'SOFT SKILLS:**

A seven day workshop on 'Soft Skills: A Key to Professional Excellence' was conducted in our College from 1<sup>st</sup> June to 7<sup>th</sup> June 2014 in order to equip the teaching faculty with requisite soft skills to facilitate the teaching-learning process by improving the quality of teaching, motivating the academic fraternity to achieve excellence in imparting knowledge and fine-tuning their presentation skills and analytical ability. - Email on the Internship and Certification course in Capital Markets with Tata Securities was circulated to the students.
- Campus Connect event was organized in the month of July as per the recommendation of the Placement Committee.
- **Campus Connect:**  
Campus Connect is primarily a Placement awareness event which is undertaken to update and educate students about placements. This event involves seminar where a company official interacts with the students educating them about job opportunities and how one prepares for employability post graduation or on course completion.
- **Need of Campus Connect event:**  
The placement Committee felt the necessity of organizing this event in order to raise awareness amongst students of all streams about the importance of placements post their course completion.
- **Objective of the Event:**

Increasing awareness amongst students about placements and educating them about the importance of taking part in placement process of the college.

- **Process & Description:**

Companies were intimated about the event through emails and personal visits about the event and informed on the details of the event in June-July. Accordingly, dates were fixed after the companies confirmed their participation. Seminar Hall and Juhu Jagruti Hall were booked as per the dates available for conducting the event.

- The event was organized and coordinated by the Student Coordinators of the Training & Placement Cell of the College under supervision of the Placement Committee. The faculty members in the committee helped in educating the students of the importance of attending the event.
- For the event, a lot of NM Alumnus visited the campus to interact with students and shared their experience during campus placements.

**BristleCone (Mahindra Group Company) came on campus for B.Sc. & M.Sc. IT/CS Students on 26<sup>th</sup> August.**

**The salary offered by them is 3.3 Lacs per annum.**

\*Usually, regular campus recruitments start by November every year but the above company for IT/CS showed interest to complete the process in August itself.

Note:

Students who have not registered for Placements were those who were not eligible for the same as they did not fulfill the minimum 75% attendance criteria for the Training sessions in their second year. Some of the students also wanted to go for further studies hence they did not register.

Tech Mahindra came on campus for B.Sc. IT/CS Students on 09th September. They selected three BSc (IT) students from NM College. The salary offered is 2 Lacs per annum. TCS (TATA Consultancy Services) for all Graduates on 16th September. They selected two (BCom) students. The salary offered is 2 Lacs per annum. Great Place To Work came on campus for all Graduates on 23rd September. They selected two students (one each from BAF & BMS). The salary offered is 4.2 Lacs per annum.

Regular Campus Recruitment\*:

1. Barclays Bank came on campus for Self Finance and Commerce Students on 14<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014.

They selected three students (2 BAF & 1 BMS) College.  
The salary offered is 5.18 Lacs per annum.

2. KPMG came on campus for Self Finance and Commerce Students on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2014.

They selected eight (5 BAF/1 BFM/3 BMS) students.  
The salary offered is 2.74 Lacs per annum.

3. EY (Ernst & Young) came on campus for Self Finance and Commerce Students on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014.

They selected Five students (3 BAF/2 BMS).  
The salary offered is 2.5 Lacs per annum.

\*Usually, regular campus recruitments start by November every year but the above companies showed interest to complete the process in October before board exams in October - November.

The salary offered is 2.74 Lacs per annum.
