On 16th December 2015, the Guest Lecture Series Committee organised another interesting session for the students and staff of degree college on the hot topic of “Will Abenomics work in Japan?”. The main focus of the session was on Japan’s struggle with recession and a critique of the economic reforms package being implemented by the Japanese P.M Shinzo Abe to revive the Japanese economy. The guest speaker was Dr. Indradeep Ghosh, a Ph. D from MIT and an Associate Professor at Meghnad Desai Academy of Economics who gave an interesting account of the macro-economic trends in Japan and also highlighted the ineffectiveness of the monetary and fiscal stimulus to revive the Japanese economy in the current context.
