# STUDENTS' WEEK 2016

## **Details** –

- **17<sup>th</sup> December, 2016 : T-Shirt and Hoodie Day, Social Cause Day and Challenge Day.**

The first day of the students' week.

- With regards to NM T-shirt and Hoodie Day, we had started pre-registrations for T-shirts and Hoodies from 1<sup>st</sup> of December and conducted the registrations till 5<sup>th</sup> of December. We distributed the same on the following days – 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of December.

This was the second Day of the Students' week.

- Students had to wear same color/pattern clothes as their friends did. We conducted a game called as Doppelganger. It was a game to test how well the friend knew his/her partner. There were 4 rounds –

Round 1 – Entangled, a physical challenge

Round 2 – Paper Dance. The pairs had to dance on the paper and each time the music stopped, they had to fold it.

Round 3 – Blindfold. One of the partners was blindfolded and the other had to direct the blindfolded partner towards him/her only through the use of directions.

Round 4 – Question and Answer Round. A questionnaire of 7 questions was prepared and given to all the participants. They had to fill it through their perspectives. The partners were separated and standing on opposite sides. The host of the event collected all the questionnaires and started the game. When the question was asked, partner 1 had to say his/her answer and then partner 2 had to say his/her answer. If the answers matched, they had to take a step closer towards their partner.

We had tie and this game and a tie breaker challenge was conducted.

Also, for other students, we had different stalls where one minute games were being conducted.

This was the third day of the Student's week.

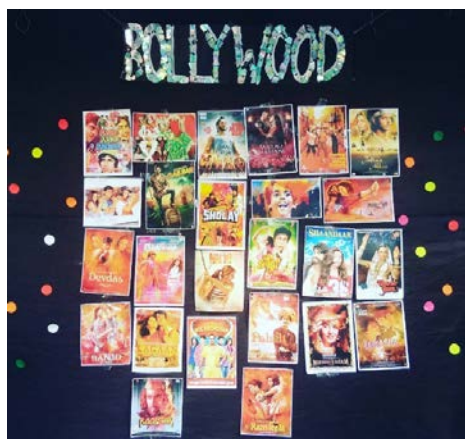
