Sherlock MBA: The first event of the year, Sherlock MBA held on 28th and 31st July, 2014, involved the exploration of the participants' intellectual skills, reasoning ability and their competence to work in teams to find solutions for various administrative problems and ethical dilemmas in the real business world. The contestants had to come up with solutions for the situations and give presentations, which was followed by the question answers session. 23 teams competed in the first round held on 28th July, 2014, out of which 7 made it to the final round on held on 30th July, 2014. The judges Mrs. Shefali Kamdar and Mrs. Chitra Thomas, enjoyed the discretion of asking the participants to switch sides and speak FOR or AGAINST the assigned topics. This resulted in the participants juggling between two sides of the same topic, thereby bringing to light their latent talent and spontaneity.
