

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
Student's feedback on Curriculum



The majority of respondents rated the program as well-organized, with 46% saying it was "Very organized" and 35% saying "Extremely organized." Only a small portion (4%) found it "Not very organized," and none found it completely disorganized.


The present curriculum equips students with the skill sets & competence required on the job. 17% 24% Strongly Agree 11 Agree 12 Neutral 14 Disagree 8 30% Strongly disagree 1 26%

Opinions on the curriculum's effectiveness are mixed: 30% of respondents are neutral, while 26% agree and 24% strongly agree that it equips students with necessary job skills. However, 18% express disagreement, including a small 2% who strongly disagree.




The majority of respondents (74%) indicated that 85–100% of the syllabus was covered in class. An additional 20% reported 70–84% coverage, while only a small fraction (6%) experienced less than 70% syllabus coverage.

The Teacher made use of adequate teaching-learning tools and materials to facilitate yourlearning process.




According to the responses, 96% of students agreed that the teacher used adequate teachinglearning tools and materials, while only 4% disagreed. This indicates a strong positive perception of the teacher's use of educational resources. The institute/teachers have used student centric method, such as experiential learning, participati ve learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.




A significant majority of respondents felt that student-centric methods were well utilized, with 46% indicating "To a great extent" and 43% saying "Moderately." Only a small fraction (9%) felt these methods were used very little or not at all.

Student's feedback on placement/internship opportunities


The institute takes active interest in promoting Training and placement support activities-



Most respondents believe the institute actively promotes training and placement support, with 39% saying it happens "Regularly" and 37% saying "Often." Very few reported limited efforts, and none felt such activities were completely absent.




A majority of respondents view the Training & Placement cell as effective, with 41% finding it "Somewhat effective" and 28% rating it "Very effective." However, 9% found it ineffective, and 20% remained neutral.





Are you satisfied with the internship assistance extended by the college?



Student's feedback on cocurricular, extracurricular activities and skills



The majority of respondents (63%) either strongly agree (41%) or agree (22%) that teachers encourage participation in extracurricular activities. Meanwhile, 26% remain neutral, and only 10% express disagreement, indicating overall positive encouragement from teachers.



The majority of respondents (78%) feel that the institute/teachers make significant efforts to develop soft skills, life skills, and employability skills. Only a small percentage (around 9%) believe that such efforts are minimal or lacking.
