Finance Fusion - Where Knowledge Meets Success

Intent, The Entrepreneurship Development Cell of Narsee Monjee College of Commerce and Economics commenced it's first event, Finance Fusion, with an energetic jamming session featuring two talented singers, setting the tone for an inspiring and vibrant atmosphere. Following the musical interlude, CA Vijay Satra took the stage, sharing his expertise on the significance of investing, financial planning and investment strategies. Our esteemed principal, Dr. Parag Ajagaonkar, delivered an enlightening speech on entrepreneurship and fostering a problem-solving mindset within an entrepreneurial framework. His words resonated with the audience, emphasizing the importance of innovative thinking in the modern world.

We then welcomed the renowned influencer and founder of KAGR, Mr. Kushal Lodha, as the main speaker of the event. Mr. Kushal, a CA, CFA, and ACCA, shared his journey and valuable insights with over 150+ attendees, weaving his personal experiences into his talk. In his engaging two-hour talk, Mr. Kushal discussed his approach to building a personal brand on social media while maintaining a corporate career. He highlighted that personal branding facilitated connections and credibility that proved invaluable in his journey.

He then delved into the challenges of transitioning from a secure corporate job to the unpredictable world of startups. He stressed the importance of caution when considering such a shift, that passion must be balanced with practicality. Sharing his CA journey, Mr. Kushal highlighted three pivotal lessons: multitasking for work-life balance, the importance of patience, and the power of consistency. These skills, he emphasized, were instrumental in his startup venture.

The speaker underscored the significance of financial knowledge even in tech startups. He revealed that a thorough understanding of finance is key for strategic decision-making, regardless of the nature of the business. Mr. Kushal elucidated the value of personal branding in establishing trust and credibility. He explained how this branding led to connections that would have been otherwise inaccessible. He noted that companies are now focusing on employee branding for similar reasons. He then, introduced his startup, 'KAGR,' which bridges the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical skills required in corporate jobs. He highlighted the importance of up-skilling while maintaining a balance with academics.

Mr. Kushal advocated a self-learning attitude as essential for personal growth. He highlighted the role of networking in today's landscape, sharing real-life examples to emphasize the importance of persistence and follow-ups. The session concluded with a dynamic Q&A where attendees engaged with him. He provided insights on pursuing CA, CFA, and starting a business. Noteworthy questions were rewarded with signed copies of his book.



This included exploring startups, angel investors, venture capital, private placements, and IPOs. Additionally, the discussion covered private equity real estate and its career potential.

Future of Demat Accounts: Mr. Barat offered a thought-provoking prediction of a significant rise in Indian demat accounts by 2030, reaching 100 crore. This sparked discussion among attendees about the future of financial markets.

Interactive Q&A Session: An engaging question-and-answer session followed, allowing students to directly interact with Mr. Barat. Questions ranged from startup and stock market inquiries to IPO valuation specifics. This exchange provided valuable real-world insights and
