Minutes of the meeting of Academic Council held on 6th April 2022 at 2.30 Pm via MStears App online.

1. The Academic Council meeting began with the address by Dr. Parag Ajagaonkar. He welcomed the members and gave an overview of the college functioning since the last meeting.
 - i. Dr. Ajagaonkar informed the council that examinations of Semester 4 and 6 of UG programs were conducted in offline mode with duration of 1 hrs 45 mns for 50 marks paper to be scaled to 75 marks. Semester 2 exam scheduled in April/May 2022 will also be conducted offline.
 - ii. Under Autonomy we propose to introduce new UG and PG programs. M.Com. (Business Analytics), B.Com. (Economics) and B.Com.(Economics and Analytics).
 - iii. He further added that common curriculum for identical programmes at UG & PG level at N M College & Mithibai College will be implemented progressively from Academic Year 2022-23.
 - iv. Between August and December 2021, 83 students were placed in reputed firms. Around 50 percent of the students received Rs. 5 Lacs plus package
 - v. Certificate courses in Behavioral Economics, Academic writing, Advanced excel and Power Business Intelligence were conducted during Academic Year 2021-22.
 - vi. He further proposed conducting a common entrance exam with Mithibai College for self-financing programmes at First Year UG level from A.Y. 2022-23.
 - vii. The plan for new UG and PG programmes is to have 2 divisions per programme. The current programmes with 1 division will have 2 divisions and programmes with 2 divisions will have 3 divisions from A.Y. 2022-23. This will be subject to availability of space for new programmes and new divisions.
 - viii. Courses in PG programmes of 6 credits will be of 90 hours duration with 60 hrs classroom teaching and 30 notional hours of learning.
 - ix. Dr. Ajagaonkar informed the members that College is working on the guidelines in National Education Policy and we are in the process of drafting an Institutional Development Plan under the guidance of Management.
2. Dr. Kavita Laghate appreciated the common curriculum idea for the two colleges. She enquired whether there is a coordination committee to support the common curriculum. Dr. Ajagaonkar mentioned that we have a committee of Principals, Vice Principals, Coordinators and Controller of Examinations. Dr. Laghate also enquired regarding subject experts. Dr. Nirmala Chavan explained that Heads of Departments have meetings and discuss the curriculum frequently.
3. i. Ms. Tessy Philji presented the course structure with credits for B.Com. programme and placed minutes of meeting of BOS for Commerce for approval of Academic Council. She explained the different courses to be implemented in 2022-23 by the Commerce Department in F.Y.B.Com
ii. Ms. Anupama Jawale then explained the new programme- M.Com. (Business Analytics) and placed minutes of BOS meeting for approval of Academic Council. She explained the selection of courses in the programmes were according to the objectives and expected outcomes of the

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programme. Mrs. Kher enquired about the objectives of the programme. She suggested that objectives should be according to Bloom's taxonomy.

iii. Mr. Prathamesh discussed the commerce related subjects in M.Com. (Banking and Finance) for the Academic Year 2022-23. Dr. Laghate raised a query regarding Basel norms. Mr. Prathamesh explained that due diligence and Basel norms are included in the course of Credit Management.

iv. Ms. Ashwini discussed the commerce related subjects in M.Com. (Business Management) for the Academic Year 2022-23.

4. Ms. Sneha Choithani presented the syllabi of Economics Courses for UG first year and PG Semester 3 and 4 and placed minutes of BOS for Economics for approval of Academic Council. She also presented for approval 2 new programmes to be introduced in 2022-23- B.Com. (Economics) and B.Com.(Economics and Analytics). The said programmes were approved by the BOS for Economics.
5. i. CA Savita Desai explained the courses in Accountancy for B.Com Programme to be implemented in 2022-23 and placed minutes of BOS for Accountancy for approval.
ii. CA. Pratiksha Jain presented the courses in M.Com. (Advanced Accountancy).
iii. Mr. Prathamesh Tawade presented the courses related to Accountancy and Finance in M.Com.(Banking and Finance) programme.
6. Mr. Sunil Kadam presented the Mathematics and Statistics syllabus for first year B.Com Programme and placed minutes of BOS of Mathematics and Statistics for approval of Academic Council.
7. Dr Jennifer D'souza presented the syllabi and evaluation pattern for Business Communication courses for B.Com Programme Semester 1 and 2 and placed minutes of meeting of BOS for Business Communication for approval of Academic Council.
8. Dr. Deepa Chitnis presented the changes in Semester 3 and 4 of syllabus of Business Law and minutes of meeting of BOS in Law for B.Com Programme for approval of Academic Council.
9. Ms. Geeta Desai presented the syllabi and evaluation pattern for Foundation Course of B.Com Programme for Semester 1 and 2 and minutes of BOS for Foundation Course for approval of Academic Council.
10. Ms. Vaishali Kurhekar presented the syllabi and evaluation pattern for Environmental Studies Semester 2 for B.Com Programme and minutes of BOS of EVS for approval of Academic Council.
11. Ms. Heena Bhuvra presented the new courses and credits added to the first year syllabi in B.M.S programme and minutes of BOS for B.M.S for approval of Academic Council.
12. Ms. Reeta Jain presented Semester 2 syllabi of B.M.S programme.
13. Ms. Anupama presented the changes in the B.Sc.IT programme and placed the minutes of BOS meeting for B.Sc.IT for approval. She explained details of the additions and the purpose of adding the topics.
14. Dr. Satra presented for approval and explained the new courses and credits added to the First Year syllabi in B.Com. Honors programme.

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15. Ms. Akshaya Bagwe presented for approval and explained the new courses and credits added to the first year syllabi in B.F.M programme and placed minutes of BOS meeting for B.F.M for approval of Academic Council.
16. Ms. Neeta Vaidya presented for approval and explained the new courses and credits added to the first year syllabi in BAF programme and placed minutes of BOS meeting for BAF for approval of Academic Council.
17. Ms. Sneha Choithani presented to the Council the dates of results of odd semesters and the result analysis. Then she explained the examination pattern that will be followed for all UG and PG programmes. The semester end exams for even semesters conducted in March 2022 had 50 marks exam scaled to 75 marks. Duration was 1.5 hrs with 15 minutes additional duration was provided. The change in remuneration for internal and external examiners was placed for approval.
18. Dr. Parag Ajagaonkar placed all the programmes' syllabi and minutes of meeting of BOS of all department and programmes for approval of the Council. The Academic Council members unanimously approved the minutes of BoS meetings, programmes and syllabi.
