



1. The Academic Council meeting began with the address by Dr. Parag Ajagaonkar. He welcomed the members and gave an overview of the college functioning since the last meeting.

Dr. Ajagaonkar informed the council about:

- a. The College being ranked 3rd among Private Autonomous Colleges in India by Education World Rankings and ranked 1st among Commerce Colleges in Maharashtra by Open Magazine Ranking.
- The CA Rank Holders July 2022 being Kushagra Agarwal AIR 20,
 Vedant Gada AIR 37 and Maitri Shah AIR 50
- c. The dates of examinations of Sem II, Sem IV, sem VI and result declaration -Dr. Ajagaonkar further took the Council through the result analysis of all the UG and PG programmes.
- d. The proposed examination reforms being:
 - a) To offer last chance to apply and appear for ATKT (under Old 7 and 10 point grading scheme of UOM) Examination for students prior to autonomy (2020-21) in February/ March 2023
 - b) to shred/dispose the used answer books after every six months from the month of the respective examination instead of storing them for one year as OSM would be implemented from AY 2022-23 onwards and soft copies of answer books would be available after disposal of physical copies
- e. In sports, NM Alumnus Chirag Shetty winning GOLD at Commonwealth Games 2022, the college bagging 2 Silver Medals at the Inter- Zonal Swimming (Men & Women) Tournament, 2022-23 dated 19th September 2022, held at Panvel Sports Complex.
- f. The signing of MoU with 'Ekal Yuva' and the proposed activities and skill development programmes for the students.
- g. The Students' Conference themed around the psychological well-being of students

- 2. Dr. Ajagaonkar placed the minutes of the last Academic Council Meeting held on 6th April 2022 for approval.
- 3. Department of Accountancy:

CA Savita Desai presented syllabus and paper pattern of two courses in Accountancy for B.Com Programme to be taught in Semester III & IV in A.Y. 2023-24 and placed minutes of BOS of Accountancy for approval.

After due deliberation on paper pattern, it was decided that, the units of the syllabus that are allotted for the respective questions will be mentioned only in the template for question bank submitted to Controller of Examinations.

4. B.M.S:

Ms. Heena Bhuva presented the new courses and credits added to the Semester III and Sem IV (to be implemented in AY 2023-24) syllabi along with the respective paper patterns in B.M.S programme and minutes of BOS for BMS for approval of Academic Council.


