Seminars, Programs, FDPs and more

NM College is renowned for its demanding academic standards and top-notch teachers, which have contributed to the development of numerous outstanding individuals in the business, management, and economics disciplines. The college carried out numerous academic events in addition to the regular and efficient delivery of lectures. The year has been filled up with preparation for New Education Policy 2020 and the management and authorities devised several platform for faculty development sessions organised by NM IQAC. Various seminars, certificate programs, competitions, guest lecturers, etc. were organized and hosted during the year. Few of them have been listed below:

The Department of Business Economics conducted a session on "Behavioural Economics & Nudge Policy" as a part of the series of sessions of IQAC's Academic Quality Circle, on Friday 18th November 2022. The session was attended by faculties from various departments. The session included a skit, which demonstrated the concepts of behavioural economics in a creative and fun way, followed by an interactive activity where faculties were divided into groups and given problems related to classroom management.

The Faculty Development Program on "NEP 2020 Problems & Challenges" was conducted on 20th July, 2022 by Dr. M Srinivasan, the session focussed on elaborated discussion on challenges for implementation of NEP 2020 including inadequate infrastructure, shortage of qualified teachers, insufficient funding, resistance from stakeholders, language barriers, and the technology gap. These challenges must be addressed in order to ensure the effective implementation of the NEP and ways to overcome these challenges was the best part of the session towards the end.

Consultancy Orientation & Case Book Launch Event was conducted on 19th November 2022 at 11:00 a.m. in college premises. The faculty development session oriented and encourage the faculties of NM College to understand and adopt consultancy from Industry. A detailed standard operating process was shared with the faculty for its implementation at college level.



The IQAC conducted faculty development program on Career Advancement Scheme – CAS for the staff members. The Resource Person was Ms. Yogini Ghare, Deputy Registrar University of Mumbai. The faculties from college and sister concern unit i.e. Mithibai College attended the session and were enlightened on procedure for application, stagewise requirements and filing of documents for successful advancement of their careers.

The IQAC and Conference Committee organised the INTERNATIONAL ONE DAY INTER-DISCIPLINARY CONFERENCE REPORT on “SUSTAINABILITY IN THE POST COVID ERA” for Researchers and Academicians. The Conference was held in Three Technical Sessions on 26th November 2022, from 10 am to 3 pm on MS Teams and justified the importance of Environment Sustainability as being superior to Social and Economic Sustainability.

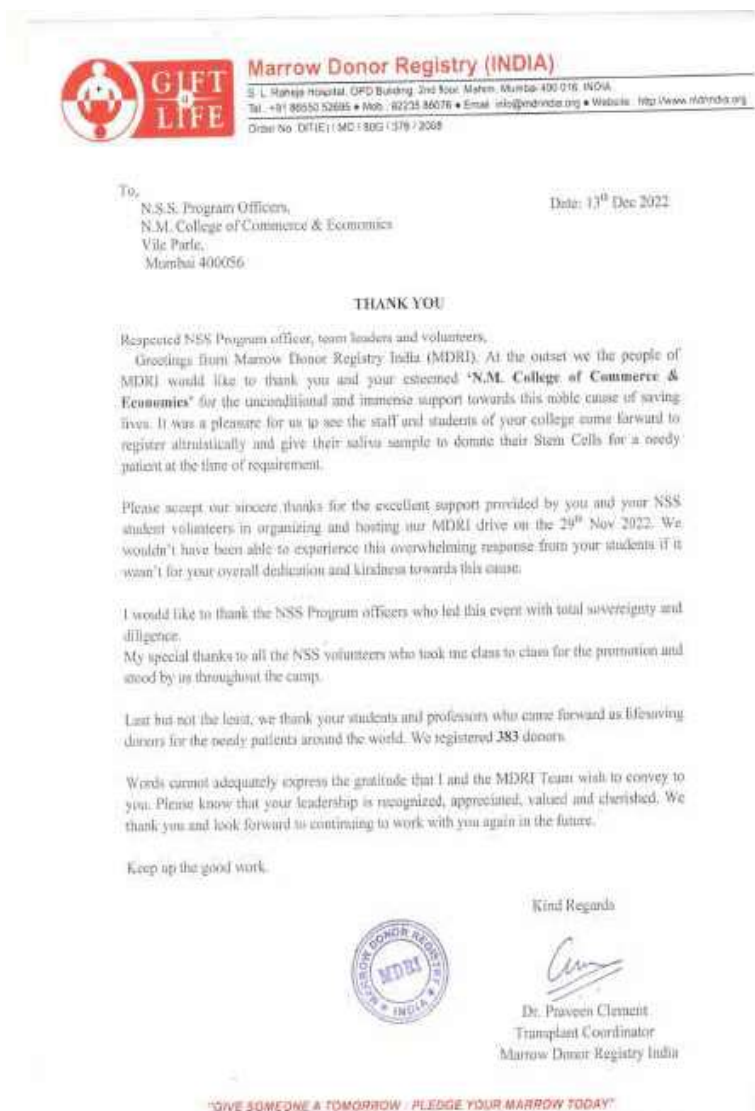

Team NMFIC along with 200+ volunteers went to various colleges and institutions to impart basic financial literacy which includes topics like tax, inflation, investments, etc. This event was registered in 7 books of records including India Book Of Records, Noble World Records, OMG Book Of Records, Worldwide Book Of Records, Golden Book of World Records, etc.

NM-NSS organised a Marrow Donation Drive in collaboration with *Marrow Donor Registry India (MDRI)*. The team received a letter of gratitude from *MDRI* recognising their efforts and support provided to encourage a staggering 383 people to register as donors.

Engagement Activities with Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC)

- 1) Learners from TYBCOM/TYBMS Semester V studying Marketing Management sold 5 Units of KVIC products each as an assignment under the guidance of the teacher in charges from Department of Commerce , i.e. Ms Tessy Philji (HoD) , Mr Smitin Belcheda , Dr Rekha Katheeth , Ms Iqra Khatri and Ms Roxy Dominic. In all sale of KVIC products approximate 2,00,000 rupees were completed by the students and an approximate amount of 8000 rs was received by college from KVIC as a 5 % vendor commission post the sales to be utilized for social and outreach extension activity. Capacity building sessions were jointly organized by Marketing Department of KVIC and Dept of Commerce for training the students and group leaders to understand the essence of KVIC and its support to MSME units. The students supported the local artisans and could comprehend better of being vocal for local brands.



- 2) Registered project learners of Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension completed their 20 hrs of work being on stalls at the 'Khadi Fest 2022' and 'Khadi Fest 2023' organized in the month of October 2022 and January 2023 respectively. Engagement with the customer for experiential learning and promotion of Khadi products were the aim of the of such participation. Students worked for 3 hrs or 5 hrs a day for a week and enjoyed being part of such exhibition which had stalls from various parts of India. In all 21 students participated and completed 20 hrs of work in the exhibition.





- 3) A student from NM-DLLE Mr Divyansh Maliwal completed his internship under Industry Orientation Project with KVIC. He successfully completed his 150 hrs of work and received a letter of appreciation from KVIC.
- 4) Tybcom students with the ability enhancement course at Sem VI i.e. Supply Chain Management visited and interacted with the artisans at the exhibition on 2nd Feb 2023 for understanding the traditional methods of managing their supplies and inventories. The visit was a unique of its kind as it sensitized learners for promoting Khadi products.



- 5) 'Umang 2022' Inter Collegiate festival organized by NM College received a sponsorship of rupees 80,000 from KVIC. The stalls and Khadi brands were at display during the festival, which welcomed thousands of Mumbai college youngsters for competition.
