FOURTH YEAR OF UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Admissions for in-house students to the Fourth Year of B.Com Honors have commenced from 10th June 2026.

Students are required to fill in the admission form and submit it along with photocopies of all six semester mark sheets to Ms. Akshata Ghosalkar between 10.00 am to 3.00 pm from 11th June to 16th June 2026.

- Lectures for Semester VII and Semester VIII will be conducted in the evening from 5.30 p.m. to 9.30 p.m.
- Students who have successfully completed Semester V and Semester VI of the Bachelor of Commerce Programme under NEP 2020 are eligible for admission to the Fourth Year of B.Com Honors (Semester VII).
- Students are required to refer to the Course Structure mentioned in Annexure I before submitting their preference forms for specialisation under the category of MAJOR. The Course Structure provides details of the courses offered under the three options, namely Business Management, Advanced Accountancy, and Banking and Finance. Once the preference form is submitted, it cannot be changed subsequently. Course allotment will be subject to seat availability.
- Students should note that those who enrol for the Fourth Year of B.Com (Honours) will be awarded the degree only upon the successful completion of all eight semesters as per the provisions of NEP 2020.

 3. Complete the payment process through the selected payment gateway.

Documents Required

- College admission form with the required undertakings, signatures of the student and parent/guardian, and photographs of both the student and parent/guardian.
- Copies of Semester I, II, III, IV, V and VI grade cards/mark sheets.
- Copy of disability certificate/proof of learning disability issued by the authorised authority (if applicable).
- Copy of Caste Certificate (if applicable – SC/ST/OBC/NT from Maharashtra State only).
- Receipt of online fee payment.
- Self-attestation of all documents by the student is mandatory.

Submission of incorrect or forged documents is a punishable offence.
