**INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS FOR ABT/ PRACTICAL
PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION DEC. 2025**

1. You are required to be seated in your respective room by sharp 12:00 noon.
2. Do not bring any books, notes, annotations or scribbled papers or speak or communicate in any manner with any other candidate(s), person(s) during the examination.
3. Mobile phones, smart watches or fitness band and such other gadgets are not allowed during the examination session. If you are found with any such gadget, you will be considered to have used 'Unfair Means' during the exam and strict action shall be initiated against you, as per the examination rules of the Maharashtra State Education Board.
4. You will be thoroughly frisked before entering the exam block.
5. Answer-book must be submitted to the Supervisor, in person, before leaving the examination hall. Do not leave the answer book unattended on the Teacher's table and do not leave without taking the permission of the Supervisor.
6. No student will be allowed to leave the examination hall before the end of the session.
7. Unused Exam stationery should be returned to the Supervisor.
8. Do not tear any part of the exam stationery.
9. You cannot bring your bag in to the exam room. You are required to carry your stationery out, collect your bag and leave the campus immediately after the examination session.
10. **The college is not responsible for any loss of valuables.**
