INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS FOR FYJC SECOND TERMINAL EXAMINATION, MARCH/APRIL 2024

- Carry your Hall-Ticket and wear the identity card during the examination period.
- Occupy your seat 45 minutes before the commencement of examination in each subject.
- Do not bring any books, notes, annotations or scribbled papers or speak or communicate in any manner with any other candidate(s), person(s) during the examination.
- No mobiles to be carried in to the Examination hall.
- You are required to sit in the designated seat according to the door plan.
- You are required to reach the examination centre one hour prior to the scheduled time to check if there are any changes in the seating arrangements. Generally seating arrangements remain the same for compulsory subjects viz. English, OCM, Economics, BK & A/C and is likely to change for optional subjects like Math & Stats / SP, Hindi / Marathi / Gujarati / French / IT.
- Answer-book must be submitted to the Supervisor, in person, before leaving the examination hall. Do not leave the answer book unattended on the Teacher's table and leave without taking the permission of the Supervisor.
- No student will be allowed to leave the hall after the warning bell.
- Mobile phones, smart watches or fitness band, ear buds/air pods or any other wireless or wired head sets and such other gadgets are not allowed during the examination session. If you are found with any such gadget, you will be considered to have used 'Unfair Means' during the exam and strict action shall be initiated against you as per the Board Examination rules.
- Students should not reveal their name, roll number, sap id etc anywhere on their answer booklet, other than the place meant for the same. If found doing so, it will be considered as unfair means case.
- Unused Exam stationery should be returned to the Supervisor.
 Do not tear any part of the exam stationery.

- If you are found indulging/involved in any of the unfair means, you will have to face the consequences of the same. Strict action will be taken against students found copying or adopting any kind of malpractice during the exams as per Board Examination rules.
