FYJC ABT/PRACTICAL EXAM March/April 2023**

- Occupy your seat 45 minutes before the commencement of examination in each subject.
- Do not bring any books, notes, annotations or scribbled papers or speak or communicate in any manner with any other candidate(s), person(s) during the examination.
- **No mobiles to be carried in to the Examination centre.**
- You are required to sit in the designated seat with your Roll number.
- Answer-book must be submitted to the Supervisor, in person, before leaving the examination hall. Do not leave the answer book unattended on the Teacher's table and leave without taking the permission of the Supervisor.
- No student will be allowed to leave the hall after the warning bell.
- Mobile phones, smart watches or fitness band and such other gadgets are not allowed during the examination session. If you are found with any such gadget, you will be considered to have used 'Unfair Means' during the exam and strict action shall be initiated against you as per the Board Examination rules.
- Unused Exam stationery should be returned to the Supervisor.
Do not tear any part of the exam stationery.
- **If you are found indulging/involved in any of the unfair means, you will have to face the consequences of the same. Strict action will be taken against students found copying or adopting any kind of malpractice during the exams as per Board Examination rules.**
