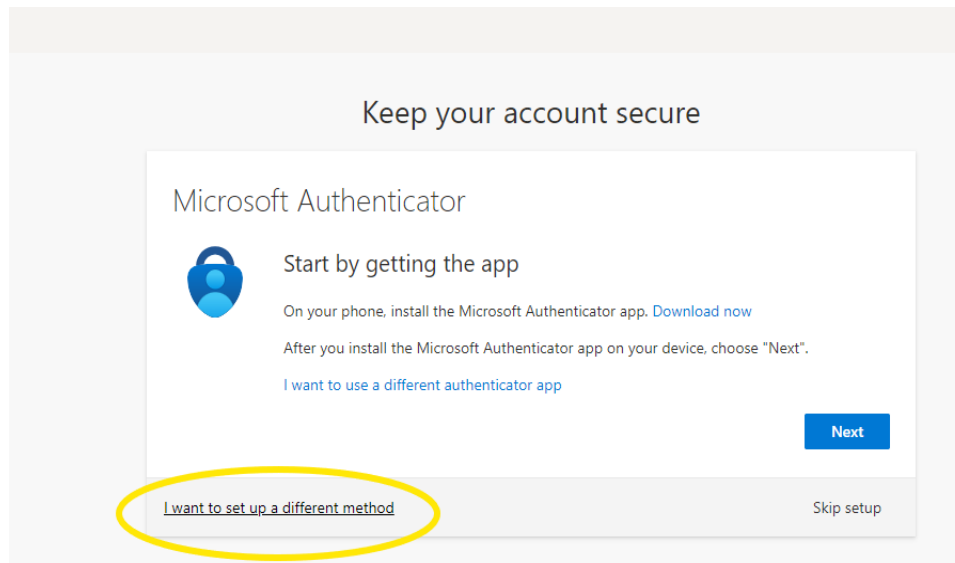
How to Register Additional Sign-In Methods for Account Security

This guide provides step-by-step instructions on how to register additional sign-in methods to enhance the security of your account. Follow the steps below to add a new sign-in method.

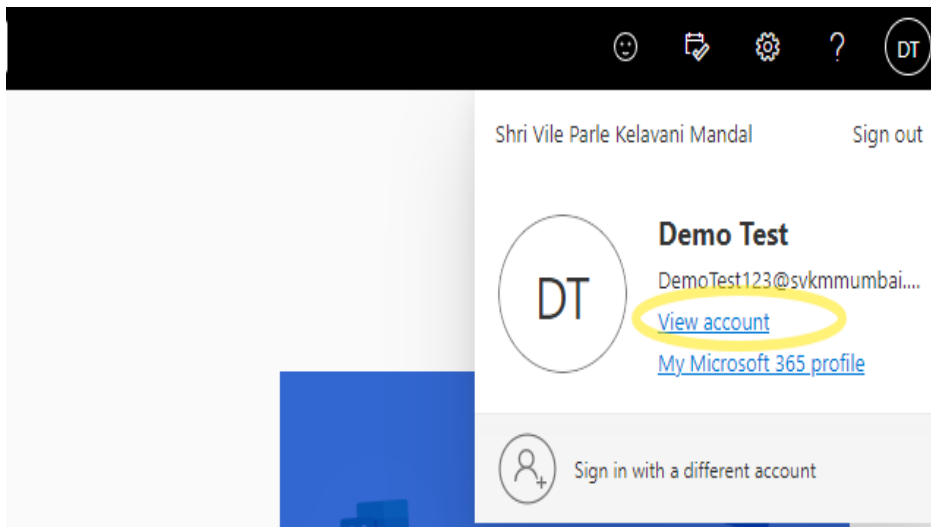
Step 1: Go to Security Info

1. Log in to your account.

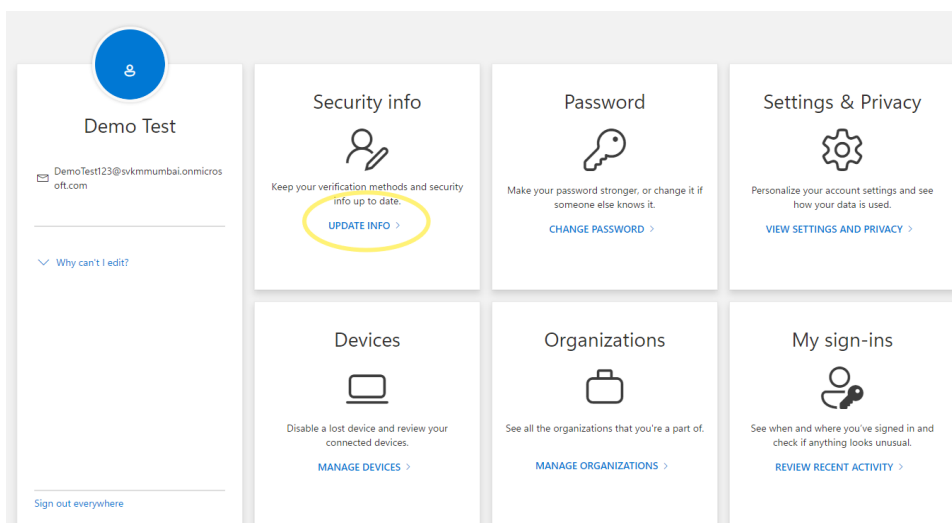
If you will get Pop-Up Message with below screenshot, then click on **I want to set up a different method.** -- > **Continue from Step 2.**



Else, ***Follow point 2.***

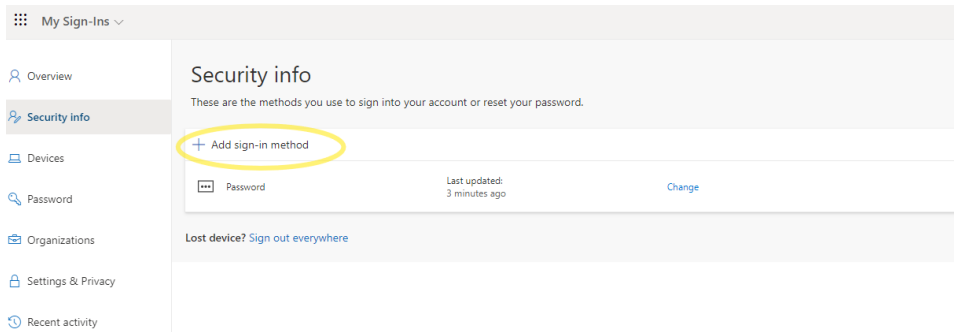


2. Navigate to the 'Security info' section by clicking on the 'Update Info' link.



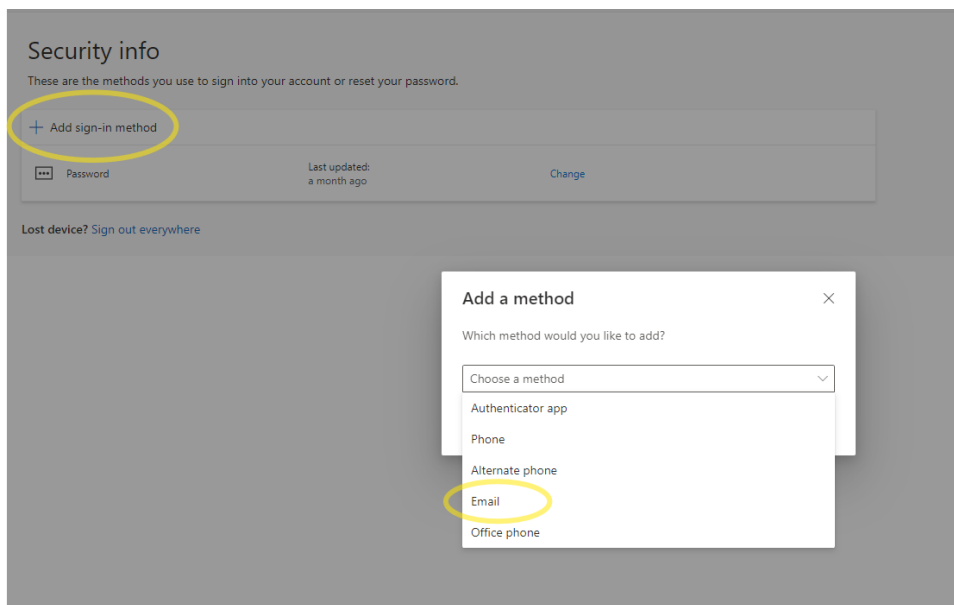
Step 2: Add a Sign-In Method

1. In the 'Security info' section, click on the '+ Add sign-in method' link.



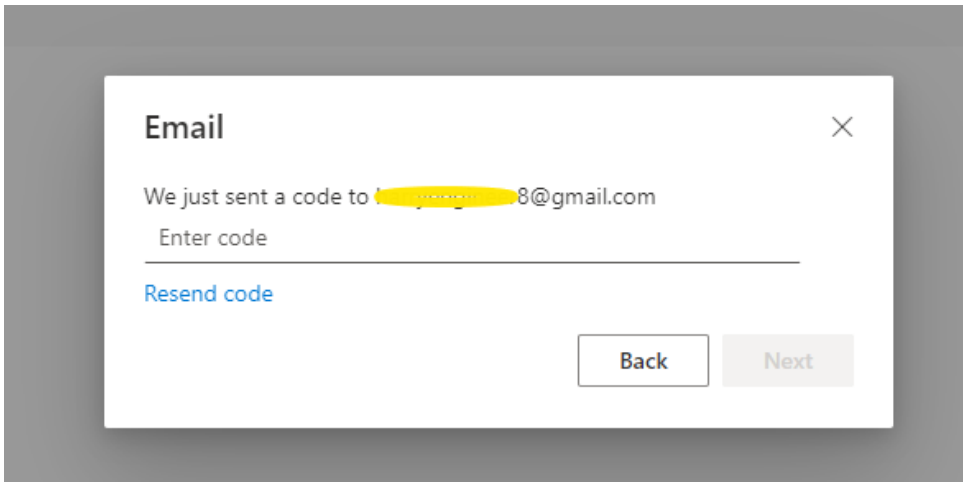
Step 3: Choose a Method

1. A new window will appear. Choose 'Email' from the dropdown menu.



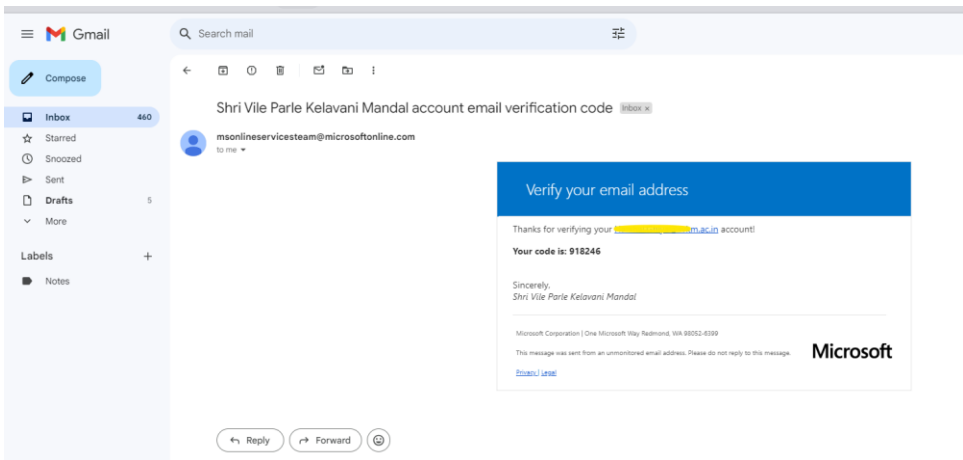
Step 4: Verify Email

2. Click 'Next' to send a verification code to the specified email address.



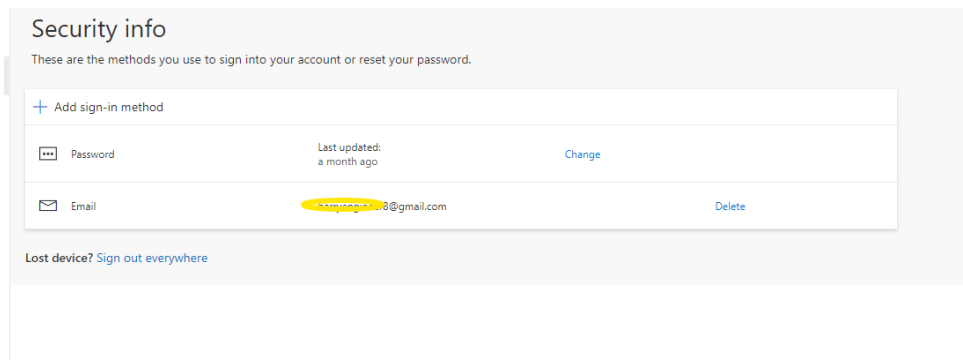
Step 5: Enter Verification Code

2. Enter the code in the provided field and click 'Next'.




Step 6: Confirm Sign-In Method
