



## Admission to SYBMS (Bachelor of Management Studies)

### Instructions for Submitting Preference Form

Students are advised to read this notice carefully before selecting the order of preferences in the Course Preference Form.

- **No change in course will be permitted** in Semester III or Semester IV once a course is allotted in Semester III under the respective category.
- Preferences will be collected through a form; however, **course allotment will be subject to seat availability.**
- Students must submit their preferences **carefully in order of priority** (e.g., 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc.).

#### Important:

In certain categories, selection of a course in Semester III will lead to **automatic allotment of a specific course in Semester IV**, based on syllabus continuity.

You are therefore requested to **refer to the table below** before marking your course preferences in the Admission Form for Semester III.


