Instructions for Submitting Preference Form

Students are advised to read this notice carefully **before selecting the order of preferences** in the Course Preference Form.

- **No change in course will be permitted** in Semester V or Semester VI once a course is allotted in Semester V under the respective category.
- Preferences will be collected through a form; however, **course allotment will be subject to seat availability.**
- Students must submit their preferences **carefully in order of priority** (e.g., 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc.).

Important:

The students can choose Combo 1 for Major in Accountancy, Combo 2 for Major in Commerce and Combo 3 for Major in Statistics. The students should note the dependency of VSEC Courses for each Combo.

In case of MAJE (Major electives), the selection of a course in Semester V will lead to **automatic allotment of a specific course in Semester VI**, based on syllabus continuity.

You are therefore requested to **refer to the table below** before marking your course preferences in the Admission Form for Semester V, for two Categories Major and MAJE.
