Also in our yearly NSS Residential Camp, our volunteers took up the task of constructing 3 benches outside a Shiva Temple at Kokner Village.

SPARV makes sure that the less fortunate people benefit from our attempts at smoothening their lives and spread awareness. A slight stimulus from our end can make great changes in the lives of these people.

PRAGATI

A social empowerment initiative



Project Pragati poses to empower and enhance all the sections of our society by speaking about the various stigmas which are considered to be taboos in the society. It includes introducing topics like Sex Education among teenagers, Women Empowerment, and various other social issues which will help sensitize our society and bring about a mental overhaul.

Inculcating basic sex education is necessary to help shape young minds in the right direction. Teenagers experiencing these changes may have many misconceptions regarding this subject and may not have any reliable source to get accurate information from.

The sessions on menstrual hygiene and self-defense fulfilled the purpose of raising awareness among young children about its necessity. A speaker session on LGBTQ Inclusivity helped in clearing doubts among the minds of young students regarding different genders and raised awareness on how all kinds of members of the society must be welcomed.

KADAM

A step towards a cleaner and greener environment



Project KADAM

is about taking steps towards a clean environment by carrying out waste management drives and by creating awareness about sustainable alternatives to our urban lifestyles.

Tetra-Pak recycling ,a project where tetra packs were collected, cleaned, and deposited at Sahakari Bhandar for recycling. With great success, the total number of tetra packs collected was above 2000.

Bottles for change is an initiative undertaken in collaboration with Bisleri. The plastic collection drive was conducted on consecutive Wednesdays for 4 months. The response was remarkable, with us collecting 63kgs of plastic.

Saptarang aimed at wall-painting and beautification of 'samanvay senior citizens activity center' by NSS volunteers. The plain walls were converted into beautiful mandala art walls and it was a mesmerizing image for the eyes.

A week-long E-Waste collection drive was held in collaboration with E-Incarnation for the first time this year. We managed to collect and recycle around 20 kgs of E-Waste.

Kadam's contribution to environmental protection has helped a greater cause beyond the four walls of our campus.

BLOOD DONATION DRIVE

For this daylong event we collaborated with Sion Hospital and collected a 339 blood bags. It is said that each bag saves three lives which means our event managed to save 1017 lives in just one day. This is a platform to provide service to mankind. All the members worked relentlessly towards marketing the event which helped us create awareness for the same. Everyone held their spirits high and let their passion speak for their selfless work. Any act, however small makes a huge impact on a person's life and by donating blood they proved just that.

AASHAYEIN

YOGA SESSION

On the occasion of international yoga Day, NMNSS conducted a yoga session taking inspiration from our honorable Prime minister Mr. Narendra Modi at Dixit BMC school.

The session was attended by 150 students of the primary section and conducted by 5 NSS volunteers. All the students were very eager and showed a lot of interest in learning yoga.

The volunteers made the students understand the importance of Yoga and how they can get benefit from it, followed by a few warm-up exercises, and yoga asanas by explaining the students each asana in detail while performing it.

Managing stress through pranayama builds concentration. Yoga develops and advocates us to use our body to its full potential. The asanas were chosen keeping in mind that they perform each asana with playing different games and the children enjoy and gain knowledge. It gives kids a way to express themselves, build a strong connection between what they hear and what they do.

RESIDENTIAL CAMP



NSS unit of Narsee Monjee College organized its Annual Residential Camp in Maswan Village, Palghar from 1st February 2020 to 7th February 2020 to carry out activities for rural development. The volunteers conducted various awareness sessions on personal and menstrual hygiene and environmental protection for adolescent children and the villagers. They also managed to spread awareness on women empowerment in the form of a street play, followed by a small donation of sorts to provide the people with necessities like clothes, utensils, footwear, books, toys, and food grains which were enough to put a smile on their faces.

A medical camp was held at two different locations where the doctors carried out a general health check-up, eye check-up, checked their BMI, blood pressure, and haemoglobin.

Collectively known as DAMS-Dance Music Art and Sports under this, workshops on Self-defense, dance, origami, and music were conducted for the students of the schools nearby

Sports has always been an energetic activity connecting people whilst encouraging team spirit amongst the immensely enthusiastic students therefore, a Sports Day was organized to provide them with a platform to prove their abilities.



The volunteers built three benches at a tourist spot in Kokner Village, simultaneously VanaraiBhandara or bunds were created across a stream using gunny sacks filled with locally available soil. This structure was built across the course to collect water as well as to reduce the velocity of the stream so that the rate of infiltration of water increases.

The beautification of the school, as well as the area nearby, was undertaken by the ardent volunteers, who brought life to the school walls by artistically painting informative drawings for the students.

Along with this, around 35 trees were painted under tree beautification.

On the last day, an awareness session 'Jagrukta' was conducted by notable personalities to inform the residents about various banking schemes that could be beneficial for them.

The residential camp helped the volunteers develop key life skills and was an eye-opener not only for the villagers but also for our volunteers who got an opportunity to get out of their comfort zones and work for the benefit of the society because, in the end, all it requires is "ThodasaDil and Thodisi Will".
