**Pattern:**

The said evaluation will carry only Multiple Choice Questions.  
Each subject will be of 50 marks in total.  
All questions are compulsory

The first five questions on MS form/Question paper will be as follows:

- Q.1. Enter your SAP ID.
- Q.2. Enter your Division.
- Q.3. Enter your Roll Number.
- Q.4. Select your College.
- Q.5 Select your stream.

Q.6 to Q.55 will be subject-specific MCQ's carrying 1 mark.

- Each MCQ will have 4 options with ONE correct answer

The first five questions will carry no points.

**Duration:**

Students will have one and half hours to complete and submit their evaluation assignment.

The **time table and syllabus** for the evaluation have been displayed on the website of the college.

**Attendance:**

The evaluation will be conducted in teams/ groups created for the purpose of the evaluation, while for SP subject students need to join SP team.

**Students should login 15 minutes prior to the commencement of the common evaluation.**

The said evaluation will be duly recorded. Meticulous records of the student's attendance at the evaluation shall be maintained.


Students should be present in the class for minimum of 30 minutes from the commencement of the session.
